PARISH FEAST DAY THANKS

I would like to thank everyone who took part in the Parish Feast Day. It was great to see you in the procession of ministry groups, at Mass, and at the dinner. This year we honored our newly certified Lay Ecclesial Minister Sharon Hammond and our newly ordained deacon Don Nagy. On their behalf, thank you to the Daughters of Isabella, the Knights of Columbus, and the combined choir for a beautiful celebration.

DUCKRO FAITH FORMATION ENDOWMENT

Last week, a pamphlet in the bulletin introduced a parish endowment created from a bequest from Deacon Paul's parents. It is The Robert & Isabella Duckro Endowment for Faith Formation. It will support our parish efforts to help people grow in Faith and in worship. It is an encouraging initiative. Some people asked me how this works and where the fund stands today.

There are three stages for an endowment like this. First, there is the establishment and original funding. We are now in the second stage. It is about growth. Direct gifts and estate planned gifts will grow the fund. Interest and dividends are also part of the growth. We look forward to the third stage: funding Faith formation. The income from the endowment will be spent while the balance is protected.

In 2016, the original funding of the endowment was \$40,000. Recently, Deacon Paul's parents' estate has added \$24,000 in fulfilling a pledge of \$200,000 over five years. Some individuals discovered this initiative and sent in \$ 525.00. This second stage is moving forward.

Through gifts, the endowment will grow to produce enough income to fund workshops, retreats, ministry training, or even a salary for a position that would work in Faith formation at all ages. 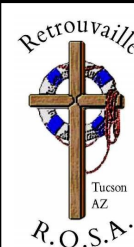
