Ignatian Silent Retreat: Gospel Contemplation

Praying the Gospel is an essential dynamic of the Spiritual Exercises of St. Ignatius. We come to know the Lord by following him as he walks among the people—healing and teaching. And as we know the Lord, we love him the more.

This year's Ignatian Silent Retreat (September 22-24) will focus on this way of praying the Gospel and on the meditations of the Second Week that lead us to reflect on the quality of discipleship in our everyday lives.

Fr. Timothy Gallagher, OMV will lead us in an exploration of the deep spirituality that is at the core of Gospel Contemplation and reflective meditation, open for us what St. Ignatius wrote about these methods in the Spiritual Exercises, and guide us in useful ways of integrating these practices in our daily prayer to let the Scriptures come alive.
