**PENNIES FROM HEAVEN**

The other day, I saw that photos in the parish school main hallway have been updated. Our principal Charlene Roll displays pictures of Sisters of Charity and seminarians in under the title "Pennies from Heaven." She reframed the photos of two of our former seminarian interns who are now priests: Fathers Edson Elizarráras and Callistus Iyoremer. Father Edson is stationed at Our Lady of Fatima in Tucson, and Father Callistus is at St. Mark in Oro Valley. She also added photos of Paul Grandi and Richard Rivera. Paul was with us in the Spring. Richard was helping us in the summer. Both are back in graduate school at the seminary in Mundelein, Illinois. Over the years, our other interns have been Fathers John Paul Shea (St. Elizabeth Ann Seton - Marana), Marco Carrasco (Sacred Heart - Nogales), and Alan Valencia (St. Anthony - Casa Grande). It is good for us to be engaged in priestly formation.

So, what is this Pennies from Heaven? It is a prayerful project to support sister and priest vocations. With leadership from our parish Knights of Columbus, for the last few years our school children collect pennies (and more) to fund scholarships. In only three weeks this August, they collected \$2,693! Although all the children should be congratulated, I must mention Emily Lopez, one of our second graders. She raised about \$700. You may have bought something from her bake sale after Mass. Since kindergarten, Emily has hosted a bake sale, because she has been enthusiastic about supporting future sisters and priests.

**SOLIDARITY WITH VICTIMS OF HURRICANE HARVEY**

Bishop Kicanas has said, "As we are all aware, Hurricane Harvey is causing terrible hardship and suffering to the people of Texas. The U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops' (USCCB) president, Cardinal Daniel N. DiNardo of Galveston-Houston, has called for prayers and solidarity with those impacted by the storm. The USCCB is working closely with affected local dioceses, Catholic Charities USA and the St. Vincent de Paul Society, along with other relief organizations, to assess the needs on the ground."

On behalf of our brothers and sisters who are experiencing catastrophic and devastating suffering, we at Saints Peter & Paul will take up an emergency collection on September 17, 2017. The collection funds will support the humanitarian efforts of Catholic Charities USA through which support to Catholic dioceses impacted will be provided.
