Bishop Manuel Moreno ordained me as a deacon for Saint Augustine Parish in June of 1996 and I served there until September 1<sup>st</sup> when Bishop Kicanas reassigned me to Saints Peter and Paul Parish. I have had two non-parish assignments. For a time I was the director of the Cursillo movement in the diocese for Bishop Moreno. At his retirement in March 2003, Bishop Moreno asked Bishop Kicanas to allow me to be his personal aide. I served in that capacity until his death November 17, 2006, actually living with him during his final years as his health declined. What a blessing!
