A NOTE FROM YOUR PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

RED MASS - OCTOBER 17

My note to you today is a "save the date." Please plan on joining Bishop Kicanas in prayer at the Red Mass. This year, it is here at **Ss. Peter and Paul at 5:30 p.m. on Tuesday, October 17.** The Mass gets its name from the red color of vestments used in Masses of the Holy Spirit. At the beginning of a judicial year, the tradition is to call upon the Holy Spirit to bless the courts and everyone involved in court proceedings. I would like to suggest three reasons for your participation:

1st: To congratulate Patrick R. McNamara.

The Saint Thomas More Society of Southern Arizona will give their annual award to our fellow parishioner Patrick R. McNamara. You may know him from his service in Mass as a lector and an Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion; in the charitable work of the St. Vincent de Paul Society, or (when his children were younger) in school projects.

The society chose him for exemplifying the virtues of St. Thomas More: integrity, courage, scholarship, commitment to the Church, prayerfulness, and wit. (For information about society membership, contact Vince Lacsamana 620-6222.)

2nd: To invite someone to attend with you.

All law students, police cadets, lawyers, judges, law enforcement members, and court workers are welcome at the Red Mass. Your invitation to them might be the only way they will hear of this. Your asking someone to attend with you will also be a gentle evangelization. These people will know God loves them and blesses their work.

3rd: To pray for justice.

Come to the Mass to pray for police, lawyers, and judges. If we want peace and security, we should work and pray for justice. This will be a wonderful opportunity to ask the Holy Spirit to give virtues to the people of the justice system.
